Setup

Requirements

Miva Merchant: **10.10**

Installation

1. Log into your Miva Merchant Admin.
2. Navigate to Domain Settings and Modules tab.
3. Click “Add Module” Button.
4. Click “Upload” Button and upload *minify.mvc*.
5. Press “Add” button.
6. Navigate to “Modules”.
7. Look for “Minify JS and CSS”.
8. Module is now installed.

Scheduled Tasks

Clear Unreferenced Resources Task

Clear Unreferenced Resources Task This task will run automatically every day. It is used for clearing the database in your store after you delete a minify resource that was in use.

Settings

Clear Unreferenced Resources Button

Clear Unreferenced Resources Button This button functions like the scheduled task, allowing you to manually clear your database.

Usage

Add Minify resource

1. Navigate to CSS/JavaScript Resources.
2. Click “Add CSS/JavaScript Resource” button.
3. Enter your custom code.
4. Select Type “Module”.
5. Select Module “Minify JS and CSS”.
6. Enter the CSS/JavaScript resource code in “Module Data” that should be modified.
7. Add the CSS/JavaScript resource to the Resource Group.

Notes

You can use the Minify Resource with Local and Combined CSS/JavaScript types of resources.

Third Party API

Toptal

Toptal This module uses the free Toptal API for minifying CSS and JavaScript, so be aware of possible risks.

Possible Errors:

- Status 413 - Too large payload (max size is 5MB).
- Status 422 - Malformed input (for invalid CSS/JavaScript).
- Status 429 - Too many requests (limit of 30 requests per minute).
